






The new school entrance and front office is still under construction and will face Cimarron Trail. There are no changes to the school start date and arrival/dismissal locations remain the same. We will continue to open the gate to the old front entrance for morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up. The Joslin team will continue to operate fully from the main hallway.

As we begin this exciting new school year, we are grateful for your partnership and commitment to our students' success. Please see the latest updates:

- im School Consolidation. Thank you to those who submitted feedback to create the tool to guide the AISD School Consolidation decision making process. Now you can access the School Consolidation Data Rubric from the Story Map and review the score for each school (based on the campus' size, condition, number of students, and how much it costs to run). The highest score a school can get is a 5, which means a big mismatch between the school's size, number of students, building condition, and/or cost. Joslin received a 3.56. However, this is NOT a school closure list that will take place in the beginning of the 2026-2027 school year.

- New School Schedule (2025-26).
 - 7:00 AM Cafeteria doors open
 - 7:30 AM Breakfast (free for students)
 - 7:40 AM Instruction begins (arrival after this is marked tardy)
 - 9:45 AM Attendance taken
 - 2:00 PM Avoid picking up students unless it's a true emergency
 - 3:10 PM Dismissal
 - To ensure safety, please avoid pickups between 2:30 3:00 PM
- Attendance Reminders. Attendance is taken at 9:45 AM daily. This is key for funding—even absences with notes (excused or not) can affect school resources. The best window for appointments is between 10:45 AM - 2:00 PM. Excessive tardy and absence will affect your child's transfer status.
 - Mental health days are not excused under state funding rules, and still count against attendance.
 - Help the school by ensuring students are here on time and not picked up early.
- **1** New AISD Rule. No student cellphones or smart watches allowed during the school day. Scan the QR code to read more!
- = Transportation & Parking. Please do not block the bus lane in front of the school by the marquee. Park in designated areas, which includes the Woodlawn Church lot.

The New Black is BLUE!








Mrs. Medina - 2nd Spanish
