

Our school is an Austin ISD summer feeding site.

- Per Texas Department of Agriculture regulations, in addition to serving students participating in on-site programs, all meal sites must also welcome any children from the community younger than 19 or enrolled students with disabilities up to 21 years old.
- Children do not need any documentation to receive free meals.
- Caregivers may accompany their children and purchase meals; breakfast \$2.75 and lunch \$4.50.
- Summer meals must be served and consumed on-campus during the designated breakfast and lunch times.
- All meal sites are closed July 1-5.

Our school will serve free summer meals for community visitors Monday-Friday from May 28,2024 to August 2,2024. Breakfast: 7:30-8:00 Lunch: 11:30-12:00
