LIBRARIAN SPOTLIGHT: MRS. GIBBS

Dear Joslin Jaguars,

I am Amy Gibbs, the Librarian, GT Advocate, and GT Teacher. In May, I will have taught for 21 years and it will be my 6th year at Joslin. I love working with the Joslin students, families, and the community. I am a mother of two. My oldest attended Joslin from kindergarten through 5th grade. My second child will be here starting prekindergarten in the fall of 2024. I welcome all to the library to come and check out a book.

What are the library's checkout policies?

- Students in Pre-K, Kindergarten, and 1st grade may check out one book at a time*.
- Students in 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade may check out up two books at a time*.
- Parents may check out up to two books at a time.
- *Please note: It is up to the discretion of teachers whether library books come home or are kept in the classroom.

We do a variety of activities in the library from read aloud, to centers, arts and crafts, research, and independent reading. My goal is that every student will find a book they enjoy, feel loved, and welcomed here.

Book Fair is coming up! This is how we raise money for the library. We use the money for books, author visits, crafts, field trips, and more. We are using Scholastic this year from April 24-28. On Monday students will come and view the Book Fair. Parents are welcome to come during the day and purchase until 3:30 pm. The rest of the week students can come and purchase during school. Tuesday and Wednesday I will stay open after school along with the music performances. We will be open on Friday as well. We need volunteers to help work the Book Fair. Please reach out if you are able to volunteer!


In AISD we have the Gifted and Talented (GT) Program along with Talent Explorer (TE). At our campus, I am the GT/TE Teacher and Advocate. I do all the testing and lead the GT Committee. I also teach the enrichment program to the students for thirty minutes to an hour weekly based on their grade level. Students have to be evaluated to participate in the program. - STAAR testing starts April. This month we are revisiting PERSERVERANCE. The STAAR test can be daunting and we don't want our students to be scared. It is a test to reflect on what they learned and already know. When something is hard, we don't give up and we continue to try; we PERSERVERE!

- Language Pathways update. 3rd graders in the trilingual program will need to determine which language to continue. Teachers will make a recommendation but the ultimate decision will be made by the parents. We understand this is not ideal for those students that excel in 3 languages and are exploring opportunities for students that are able to strive in all 3 languages. - 2023/24 updates. We have secured full time art and music teachers for next school year! We will also acquire a full time instructional coach to work with teachers to support them in the classroom. We will also be Title 1 next year.
