WE'RE NOT DONE YET

Help Refine AISD's School Consolidation Plan-Submit Your Comment Card by Oct. 28

Thank you for your continued support of Joslin Elementary! As Austin ISD moves forward with the School Consolidation process, your input is key to ensuring another successful year for our school community. The draft plan, released earlier this month, affects 98% of AISD campuses.

Understanding the Plan: Joslin Language Immersion.

Joslin is proposed to become a Language Immersion campus, offering Spanish and Mandarin for all students. Unlike Dual Language programs for English learners, Immersion helps English-speaking students learn a new language through core subjects. The current draft plan states that English-only students would not be able to enroll next school year.

Our Work Isn't Done. As the district reviews community input, some changes to the plan may affect families next school year. Principal Chang is working closely with district staff to help minimize disruptions and support Joslin's continued success. Families can do their part by submitting a Comment Card to share ideas and feedback with the district.

Submit Your Comment Card by October 28. Your feedback helps strengthen the plan and guide districtwide improvements.

Helpful feedback includes:

- Safety or access issues
- Neighborhood clustering ideas Comments like "It's a big change"

Less helpful feedback includes:

- Neighborhood-specific details Personal preferences or reputation concerns
- Campus or program concerns General comments without actionable ideas
 - Requests not to close specific schools
