

Under the guidance of our wonderful school counselor, Mrs. Turner, the Student Council is excited to engage our students in meaningful activities throughout the year.

Student Council Involvement. Our Student Council plays a pivotal role in bringing the No Place for Hate Campaign to life. Throughout the school year, they plan and execute 3 major activities that contribute to our No Place for Hate status which includes:

- 1. Pawsitives Program: An ongoing initiative that encourages students to recognize and celebrate positive behavior.
- 2. <u>The Great Kindness Challenge Week</u>: Scheduled for January 27-31, this event aligns with The Great Kindness Challenge, where students will participate in various activities promoting acts of kindness.
- 3. One School, One Book: A spring initiative designed to foster community through a shared reading experience.



Celebrating Leadership. This year's Student Council elections showcased our students' leadership skills. With 27 candidates vying for 7 positions, our 4th and 5th graders demonstrated impressive character by supporting each other, regardless of the outcome. The elected representatives, including the President, Vice President, Action Chair, Eco Chair, Advertising Chair, and PALS Chairs (4th/5th), are set to lead various initiatives. These leaders will organize events, manage recycling efforts, and coordinate buddy activities during lunch, all while exemplifying the Joslin spirit.



Upcoming Events. In addition to our ongoing initiatives, the Student Council is organizing Joslin's Annual Food Drive from Dec. 2-13.
