This year, Joslin Elementary is hosting a Jog-A-Thon to raise funds for a much-needed new blacktop! Our goal is to raise \$20,000 to give our students a safer, more enjoyable outdoor space for recess and activities.

Instead of our usual read-a-thon, we're inviting all students to participate in this fun event. It's easy to get started: simply register your child by scanning the QR code in the flyer, then share it with friends and family near and far to start fundraising. Every dollar counts toward our goal! All donations must be received by March 27th.

We also have a special way for you to support your runner! For just \$5, you can create a personalized sign to cheer on your child as they run. These signs will be displayed along the track during the event. We will have sign-making opportunities scheduled in March—more details to come!

## Austin ISD 2025-2026 Enrollment Registration Now Open!

It's that time of year—Austin ISD enrollment registration for the 2025-2026 school year is open and the deadline for Round 1 registration is approaching! We encourage all families to complete their child's registration as soon as possible to ensure a smooth transition into the next school year. To get started, simply scan the QR code below to access your Austin ISD portal and complete your registration. The first round of registration closes on February 4, so please don't wait!

Once you've completed your registration, call the front office and speak with Ms. Cris to confirm your registration. Due to some system requirements, Ms. Cris will need to confirm all registrations. It's essential to have this confirmation so we can accurately plan for staffing needs.

Why is it important to register now? Early registration helps us secure our teachers for the upcoming year and gives us ample time to hire new staff if necessary. By registering early, you're helping us ensure we have everything in place for a smooth start to the new school year. If we don't hear from you, you can expect a call from Mr. Chang or Ms. Cris to follow up on your registration.
